



Black and White Changing Tutorial  
This tutorial will show you how to turn a colored car into black or white.

## BLACK AND WHITE PAINT TUTORIAL BY BRASHER

This is quite a simple trick I learned while trying to get my painted cars looking glossy instead of the colour being flat. It doesn't work for all cars but it works particularly well on cars with lots of reflections and differences in contrast.

This is the car that I will be starting out with.



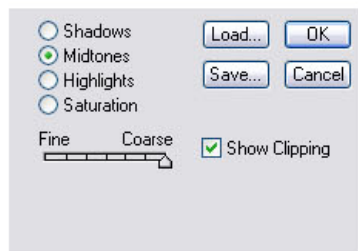
First step is to select all the parts of the car you would like to make black/white by using the polygon select tool, remembering that holding "Shift" will add to a selection while "alt" will take away from the selection.



Next you should copy and paste your selection (ctrl + c then Ctrl + v)

Once you have done that Desaturate the newly created layer by hitting Image > adjustments > desaturate

The next part is the actual colour changing part, Go to - Image > adjustments > variations and have the settings as follows.



Depending on the images you can now click the "lighter" image once or twice to have a white car, or click "darker" to have a black car. If it seems too bright or too dark then lower the sliding bar to the left a bit more until you are happy with the result. Easy huh?

These are my results:



TIP - to get different paint effects, like glossy or matt finish you should play around with the curves utility (image > adjustments > curves) or levels function (ctrl + L)

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
